## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Proud members of the Justices of the Peace and 2 Constables Association of Texas are gathering in Austin on February 3 12, 2019, for Justices of the Peace and Constables Day at the State 4 Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, The office of justice of the peace, first established in 1362 by King Edward of England, and the office of 6 constable, first established in 1215 by King John of England, were 7 two of the first offices established in the American colonies in 8 1620; both offices were created by the Texas Constitution 9 approximately two centuries later and continue to serve a vital 10 11 role in the system of county government; and

12 WHEREAS, Justices of the peace are an integral part of the 13 judiciary; they exercise jurisdiction Texas in criminal 14 misdemeanor cases punishable by fine or sanctions and exercise civil jurisdiction in matters in controversy up to \$10,000; 15 16 justices of the peace preside over those courts closest to the people, first established as "grass roots" courts in 1836 when 17 Texas became a republic; and 18

WHEREAS, Constables serve as officers of the court as bailiffs, execute civil and criminal process issued by Texas courts, and enforce criminal laws as certified peace officers; the first known constable to serve in Texas was appointed in 1823, when the region was still under Mexican rule; and

1 the offices of justice of the peace and constable perform their 2 official duties with integrity, dedication, and the required 3 knowledge of the law, thereby contributing immeasurably to the 4 justice system, the safety of the citizens of Texas, and the peace 5 and order of our society; and

6 WHEREAS, For more than 75 years, the Justices of the Peace and 7 Constables Association of Texas has represented the interests of 8 justices of the peace, constables, and members of their staffs 9 across the Lone Star State, and today the organization boasts a 10 membership of over 2,000; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas 12 Legislature hereby recognize February 12, 2019, as Justices of the 13 Peace and Constables Day at the State Capitol; and, be it further

14 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 15 prepared for the association as an expression of high regard by the 16 Texas House of Representatives.
