## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Proud members of the Justices of the Peace and
- 2 Constables Association of Texas are gathering in Austin on February
- 3 12, 2019, for Justices of the Peace and Constables Day at the State
- 4 Capitol; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The office of justice of the peace, first
- 6 established in 1362 by King Edward of England, and the office of
- 7 constable, first established in 1215 by King John of England, were
- 8 two of the first offices established in the American colonies in
- 9 1620; both offices were created by the Texas Constitution
- 10 approximately two centuries later and continue to serve a vital
- 11 role in the system of county government; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Justices of the peace are an integral part of the
- 13 Texas judiciary; they exercise jurisdiction in criminal
- 14 misdemeanor cases punishable by fine or sanctions and exercise
- 15 civil jurisdiction in matters in controversy up to \$10,000;
- 16 justices of the peace preside over those courts closest to the
- 17 people, first established as "grass roots" courts in 1836 when
- 18 Texas became a republic; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Constables serve as officers of the court as
- 20 bailiffs, execute civil and criminal process issued by Texas
- 21 courts, and enforce criminal laws as certified peace officers; the
- 22 first known constable to serve in Texas was appointed in 1823, when
- 23 the region was still under Mexican rule; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The men and women who accept the responsibilities of

- 1 the offices of justice of the peace and constable perform their
- 2 official duties with integrity, dedication, and the required
- 3 knowledge of the law, thereby contributing immeasurably to the
- 4 justice system, the safety of the citizens of Texas, and the peace
- 5 and order of our society; and
- 6 WHEREAS, For more than 75 years, the Justices of the Peace and
- 7 Constables Association of Texas has represented the interests of
- 8 justices of the peace, constables, and members of their staffs
- 9 across the Lone Star State, and today the organization boasts a
- 10 membership of over 2,000; now, therefore, be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
- 12 Legislature hereby recognize February 12, 2019, as Justices of the
- 13 Peace and Constables Day at the State Capitol; and, be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
- 15 prepared for the association as an expression of high regard by the
- 16 Texas House of Representatives.
