1 WHEREAS, Russell Faulkner received well-deserved recognition
2 for his exemplary service as a member of Gainesville Fire-Rescue
3 when his name was added to the city's firefighter memorial at a
4 ceremony on September 11, 2018; and

5 WHEREAS, During the event, bricks commemorating the
6 contributions of Mr. Faulkner and three other former Gainesville
7 first responders were officially placed in the monument; in
8 addition to acknowledging the dedicated individuals who have served
9 with the department, both the memorial and the ceremony pay tribute
10 to all those who lost their lives during the 9/11 terrorist attacks;

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Faulkner served his community for 37 years as a
13 volunteer with Gainesville Fire-Rescue from 1981 to 2018; he earned
14 the admiration of his colleagues for his strong work ethic and drive
15 to help out wherever he was needed, which at times involved
16 performing his firefighting duties late into the evening before
17 going to his regular day job the next morning; and

18 WHEREAS, Russell Faulkner's courage, commitment, and
19 professionalism greatly benefited the people of Gainesville, and he
20 may take justifiable pride in his receipt of this heartfelt honor
21 from his community; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
23 Legislature hereby congratulate Russell Faulkner on the addition of
24 his name to the Gainesville firefighter memorial and extend to him
