

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Residents of Terrell County are gathering in Austin
2 to celebrate Terrell County Day at the State Capitol; and

3 WHEREAS, Located in southwestern Texas near Big Bend, Terrell
4 County was established in 1905 and encompasses 2,357 square miles
5 of rocky terrain that is bounded on the south by the Rio Grande and
6 on the northeast by the Pecos River; this picturesque region sits on
7 the Stockton Plateau, and the landscape features gently rolling
8 plains and mountainous regions with dramatic canyons and valleys;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, After the Brown-Bassett gas field was discovered in
11 1957, oil and gas exploration in the region quickly gained
12 prominence; today, the petroleum industry continues to play a vital
13 role in the county's economy, as do tourism, hunting leases, and
14 ranching; most of the area's agricultural revenue comes from sheep
15 and goats, which are valued for wool and mohair; beef and pecans are
16 also important local products; and

17 WHEREAS, Terrell County attracts hikers, river runners, and
18 hunters with its scenic views and varied wildlife; the county seat
19 of Sanderson, known as the "Cactus Capital of Texas," celebrates
20 the region's unique plant life at the annual Prickly Pear Pachanga,
21 and other attractions include the Terrell County Memorial Museum,
22 which showcases range, railroad, and community memorabilia; and

23 WHEREAS, The people of Terrell County may take great pride in
24 their rich history as they work together to build an even brighter

2 region of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
