1 WHEREAS, David Anderson retired from the faculty of The
2 University of Texas School of Law on January 18, 2018, concluding an
3 exemplary career that spanned more than 45 years; and

4 WHEREAS, David Anderson earned his law degree at UT and
5 joined the school's faculty in 1972; he became one of the nation's
6 foremost experts on the First Amendment, free speech, mass media
7 law, and torts, and many of his students have gone on to national
8 prominence; and

9 WHEREAS, Professor Anderson lectured at universities in
10 Australia, England, Sweden, Italy, and the Netherlands, and he
11 authored or coauthored five books, including two casebooks, as well
12 as more than 50 scholarly articles; and

13 WHEREAS, He also served the state as chief counsel to the
14 Texas Judiciary Council, the policy-making body for the state
15 judiciary, and as an advisor to the Constitutional Convention of
16 1974; and

17 WHEREAS, Over the course of his distinguished tenure, David
18 Anderson earned the respect and admiration of innumerable people,
19 and his contributions to The University of Texas and to the legal
20 community will continue to resonate for years to come; now,
21 therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
23 Legislature hereby honor David Anderson for his exemplary service
24 to The University of Texas School of Law, congratulate him on his
