R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Members of the Texas Building Owners and Managers  
2 Association are gathering in Austin on February 20, 2019, to  
3 celebrate Texas BOMA Advocacy Day at the State Capitol; and

4           WHEREAS, Established in 1937 as the state federated  
5 organization of BOMA International, Texas BOMA represents the  
6 interests of stakeholders in the commercial real estate business;  
7 it is composed of 2,500 members and six federated associations in
