1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of Crockett County are gathering in
2 Austin on February 28, 2019, to celebrate Crockett County Day at the
3 State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, Crockett County covers more than 2,800 square miles
5 of majestic and varied canyons, mesas, and savannas and is home to a
6 diverse economy of ranching and oil and gas production; formed in
7 1875, the county was named after the legendary Davy Crockett and is
8 geographically the eighth largest county in the state; and

9 WHEREAS, Self-styled as the "Biggest Little Town in the
10 World," Ozona is the only town in Crockett County and is named for
11 the high quality of its open air; its attractions include the
12 Crockett County Museum, where visitors are treated to a wealth of
13 stories about the county's vibrant past and can view artifacts from
14 area residents dating as far back as 10,000 B.C.; the town also
15 hosts a junior rodeo, and the square is home to such works as the *Tie*
16 *That Binds* sculpture, in memory of pioneer families, and the Davy
17 Crockett Monument; and

18 WHEREAS, Celebrating their rich and colorful history as they
19 work together to build a bright future, the citizens of Crockett
20 County may take justifiable pride in the important role their
21 unique region continues to play in the story of the Lone Star State;
22 now, therefore, be it
