13 Farley is a senior at Crosbyton High School and has held membership
14 in the Crosby County 4-H Club for six years; she served on the
15 county banquet decoration committee and has participated in

17 rabbit, horse, meat, wildlife, photography, and geocaching;
18 furthermore, she has served her community by making dog treats and
19 beds for the local animal rescue, sorting winter clothing for
20 Lubbock Dream Center, assisting the local fire department in
21 patching roofs after a hailstorm, and helping special needs
22 students to show their first animals; and
