- 1 WHEREAS, Residents of Rowlett are gathering in Austin on
- 2 February 27, 2019, to celebrate Rowlett Day at the State Capitol;
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, The area around present-day Rowlett was first
- 5 settled in the 1840s by members of the Peters and Mercer Colonies; a
- 6 post office was set up in 1880 and named Morris, after its first
- 7 postmaster, but the name was later changed to Rowlett, after
- 8 Rowlett Creek, a tributary of the east fork of the Trinity River;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, The arrival of the Dallas and Greenville Railway in
- 11 1889 helped the town become a prosperous cotton farming community
- 12 with a school, churches, and businesses, and in 1921, it was
- 13 included on the route of the Bankhead Highway, one of the nation's
- 14 first transcontinental highways; the city was incorporated in 1952
- 15 by a vote of 84 citizens; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Today, Rowlett has grown into a thriving city of
- 17 more than 60,000 residents who enjoy 30 miles of beautiful Lake Ray
- 18 Hubbard shoreline; it has been named a Tree City USA, and
- 19 SafeHome.org has ranked it the ninth-safest city in Texas; Rowlett
- 20 has also won recognition from the Texas Economic Development
- 21 Council and the Dallas Business Journal for its economic
- 22 development achievements; the Rowlett Chamber of Commerce was
- 23 established in 1924, and it continues to play a vital role in local
- 24 development as this small, agricultural town has grown into a

- 1 modern city with a vibrant downtown business district; and
