

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Texas State Rifle Association is celebrating its
2 100th anniversary in 2019; and

3 WHEREAS, Established in 1919, the TSRA is an independent
4 organization affiliated with, and recognized by, the National Rifle
5 Association; its primary goal was to promote and encourage rifle
6 shooting through training and competitions in the state and by
7 competition with other such groups across the nation; and

8 WHEREAS, With the growth of the TSRA membership over the
9 years, youth shooting and safety programs have developed in such
10 organizations as 4-H, the Boy Scouts of America, the American
11 Legion, the National High School Rodeo Association, and ROTC; in
12 cooperation with the NRA, the TSRA sanctions state matches each
13 year in more than 20 different shooting disciplines, and the state
14 winners are eligible to advance to national competitions; and

15 WHEREAS, For many years, the TSRA has carefully monitored
16 other state legislatures and the U.S. Congress in its role as a
17 strong supporter of the rights of law-abiding citizens to own
18 firearms; the association had no active presence at the Texas State
19 Capitol until 1985, when Doc Brown advocated on behalf of TSRA for
20 the passage of a firearms preemption bill and a bill to stop hunter
21 harassment, both of which were signed into law by Governor Mark
22 White; and

23 WHEREAS, Today, the 35,000 members of the TSRA proudly
24 maintain the association's original commitment to firearm skill

2 its support for traditional hunting and its ongoing dedication to
3 firearm ownership and Second Amendment rights; now, therefore, be
