16 career as the chief financial officer for New Century Exploration
17 and the chief executive officer for True Electric; devout in her
18 Christian faith, she was a longtime member of Faithbridge Church;
19 she was also engaged in her community through active involvement
20 with a number of local organizations, including the Cypress Creek
21 Foundation for the Arts and Community Enrichment, the Alley
22 Theatre, the Houston Museum of Natural Science, and the Pearl
23 Fincher Museum of Fine Arts; and

24 WHEREAS, Above all, Ms. Martin treasured time spent with her

1 family, and she loved participating in creative projects with her
2 children as well as attending their school and sports events;
3 moreover, she delighted in traveling with her loved ones to Italy,
4 Spain, and New York and relaxing with them at their home in the
5 South Carolina mountains, their condo in Galveston, or the family
6 ranch in Brenham; she was also greatly admired for her skills as a
7 cook, gardener, and crafter; and

8 WHEREAS, Possessed of a strong, independent spirit, a zest
9 for life, and a refined elegance, Narda Rignault Martin brightened
10 the world for all who knew her, and they will forever hold her close
11 in their hearts; now, therefore, be it
