- 1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of DeSoto are gathering at city hall
- 2 on March 2, 2019, to celebrate the 70th anniversary of the
- 3 incorporation of their community; and
- WHEREAS, The first settlers were farmers, who arrived in the
- 5 immediate area in 1847, and a general merchandise store built to
- 6 meet the demand for goods opened about a year later; in 1881, the
- 7 settlement received a post office and its name, DeSoto, in honor of
- 8 beloved physician Dr. Thomas Hernando DeSoto Stewart; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Recognizing the need for an improved water
- 10 distribution system after World War II, the town's residents
- 11 presented a petition to the Dallas County judge requesting an
- 12 election for incorporation; the measure passed on March 2, 1949,
- 13 and the City of DeSoto was created; it had a population of
- 14 approximately 400 people; and
- WHEREAS, One of the oldest settlements in North Texas, DeSoto
- 16 is today a thriving and vibrant community of more than 53,000
- 17 residents; nestled among the trees and rolling hills of
- 18 southwestern Dallas County, it is a city with a record of exemplary
- 19 community engagement and has been named as a National Civic League
- 20 All-America City in honor of its civic spirit; and
- 21 WHEREAS, DeSoto offers welcoming neighborhoods, exemplary
- 22 schools, and an expanded park system, and its residents may indeed
- 23 take great pride in their history as they look forward to a bright
- 24 and prosperous future; now, therefore, be it
