1 WHEREAS, The Texas Sports Hall of Fame is recognizing the
2 exceptional accomplishments of its 2019 inductees at a ceremony on
3 March 30 in Waco; and

4 WHEREAS, Since inducting its first member in 1951, the Texas
5 Sports Hall of Fame has honored the athletic careers of more than
6 300 men and women; in 1993, the institution opened a museum in Waco
7 to chronicle the lives of these legendary individuals and to
8 preserve the history of sports in Texas for present and future
9 generations; and

10 WHEREAS, The hall of fame's Class of 2019 is made up of seven
11 exemplary athletes: the late professional tennis star Maureen
12 Connolly Brinker, former Texas A&M University and NFL placekicker
13 Tony Franklin, former Houston Texans wide receiver Andre Johnson,

15 Lieberman, former University of Arkansas football player Loyd
16 Phillips, former University of Texas and Major League Baseball
17 pitcher Greg Swindell, and retired Dallas Cowboys All-Pro tight end
