2 passing of Dovie Lee Greene Jackson on December 23, 2018, at the age
3 of 66; and

4 WHEREAS, The daughter of Shellie and Ruby O'Neal Greene, the
5 former Dovie Greene was born on September 8, 1952; she graduated
6 from Ector High School and went on to receive her bachelor's degree
7 in business administration from The University of Texas of the
8 Permian Basin; and

9 WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson was the first African American and the
10 first woman to be named deputy comptroller for the State of Texas,
11 and she served as president emeritus of the Black American
12 Comptroller Employees Association; she was recognized in 1998 as a
13 Distinguished Former Odessan by the Heritage of Odessa Foundation,
14 and UT Permian Basin named her its 2006 Distinguished Alumnus; and

15 WHEREAS, In all her endeavors, Ms. Jackson enjoyed the love
16 and support of her husband, Isaac Jackson, with whom she shared a
17 rewarding marriage; she took great pride in her three children,
18 Tracy, Isaac, and Christopher, and she had the pleasure of seeing
19 her family grow to include four grandchildren, Shamar, Brittney,
20 Briana, and Dorian; and

21 WHEREAS, Those who were privileged to share in this esteemed
22 woman's warmth and friendship will always remember her with great
23 admiration and affection; now, therefore, be it
