1 WHEREAS, Members of First Baptist Church Waxahachie
2 celebrated the dedication of their church's new home with a
3 ribbon-cutting ceremony and gospel concert on March 3, 2019; and

4 WHEREAS, First organized on March 17, 1861, FBC Waxahachie
5 started out as a small church with only 12 founding members; it has
6 since developed into a thriving congregation that has outgrown a
7 number of sanctuaries; previously located on North Rogers Street,
8 the church moved to its current campus on the U.S. Highway 287
9 bypass near Broadhead Road in December 2018; and

10 WHEREAS, Over the years, FBC Waxahachie has benefited from
11 the efforts of 12 outstanding clergymen, including the Reverend
12 David Ritsema, who has led the congregation since 2013; united by
13 their shared faith and strong traditions, the members of this
14 notable house of worship have established a variety of commendable
15 programs that foster fellowship and offer help to those in need,
16 including missions to Guatemala and Estonia; the church is
17 currently focusing on assisting children from low-income families
18 in the local community; and

19 WHEREAS, For 158 years, First Baptist Church Waxahachie has
20 played a vital role in the lives of area residents, and its
21 continued existence is a tribute to the unwavering commitment of
22 its congregants, both past and present; now, therefore, be it
