2 the passing of Charles Michael Hale on June 29, 2017, at the age of
3 63; and

4 WHEREAS, A native and lifelong resident of Quanah, Mike Hale
5 was born on December 16, 1953, to Charles Ray and JoAnn Hale, and he
6 grew up with the company of a sister, Mary Jo; in December 1975, he
7 married the former Robbie Justice, and the couple became the proud
8 parents of a daughter, Kelsey; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Hale enjoyed a rewarding career with the Quanah
10 Independent School District that spanned four decades and included
11 positions as teacher, coach, and principal; over the years, he also
12 led such extracurricular organizations as the UIL math team, and
13 his dedication to the success and well-being of every student
14 earned him the lasting respect and admiration of countless young
15 people as well as his colleagues; and

16 WHEREAS, A man of profound faith, Mr. Hale was a longtime
17 congregant at the First United Methodist Church in Quanah;
18 moreover, he was a member of the Texas Association of Basketball
19 Coaches and the board of the Texas Math and Science Coaches
20 Association; in addition to forging a respected career in
21 education, he also engaged in farming; and

22 WHEREAS, Mike Hale is deeply missed, and he will long be
23 remembered with warmth and affection by all who were fortunate
24 enough to know him; now, therefore, be it
