- 1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of Parker in Collin County are
- 2 coming together on March 30, 2019, to celebrate the 50th
- 3 anniversary of the incorporation of their city; and
- WHEREAS, The community originated in the late 1840s, as part
- 5 of the Peters Colony in Collin County; in 1846, a school was
- 6 established in a private home, and that same year, Corinth
- 7 Presbyterian Church, which still exists today, held its first
- 8 worship services; local residents eventually named their town
- 9 Parker, after William "Uncle Bill" Parker, the owner of a gin and a
- 10 gristmill; and
- 11 WHEREAS, On March 22, 1969, the residents of the community
- 12 gathered at Corinth Presbyterian Church and voted to incorporate
- 13 the City of Parker; Percy Bozeman was elected as the first mayor,
- 14 along with five aldermen, and Betty McMenamy served as city
- 15 secretary from 1972 to 2006, working out of her home until the city
- 16 hall was built; in the years since its founding, the city has grown
- 17 from 360 residents to approximately 5,000; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Parker established a volunteer fire department in
- 19 1983 and a police department in 1985, and since 1973, the city has
- 20 benefited greatly from the volunteer efforts of the Parker Women's
- 21 Club, which started with 8 members and today has 154; the famed
- 22 Southfork Ranch, location of the hit television series Dallas, lies
- 23 within the city limits and draws more than 400,000 visitors a year;
