RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 86th Legislature, That Rule 8, Section 7, of the permanent rules of the House of Representatives of the 86th Legislature is amended to read as follows, effective upon adoption by the Senate of an amendment providing a complementary process for designating and numbering bills and joint resolutions:

Sec. 7. PREFILING. (a) Beginning the first Monday after 7 the general election preceding the next regular legislative 8 session, or within 30 days prior to any special session, it shall be 9 in order to file with the chief clerk bills and resolutions for 10 introduction in that session. On receipt of the bills or 11 12 resolutions, and as provided by Subsection (b), the chief clerk shall designate and number them and make them a matter of public 13 14 record, available for distribution. Once a bill or resolution has been so filed, it may not be recalled. This shall apply only to 15 16 members-elect of the succeeding <u>legislature</u> [legislative session].

- 17 (b) For the 87th and succeeding legislatures, the chief 18 clerk shall:
- 19 (1) designate each bill received as a "Texas Bill" (or 20 T.B.) and number the bill using only odd numbers if the general 21 appropriations bill will originate in the house for that 22 legislature;
- 23 (2) designate each bill received as a "Texas Bill" (or
 24 T.B.) and number the bill using only even numbers if the general

1	appropriations bill will not originate in the house for that
2	legislature;
3	(3) designate each joint resolution received as a
4	"Texas Joint Resolution" (or T.J.R.) and number the joint
5	resolution using only odd numbers if the general appropriations
6	bill will originate in the house for that legislature; and
7	(4) designate each joint resolution received as a
8	"Texas Joint Resolution" (or T.J.R.) and number the joint
9	resolution using only even numbers if the general appropriations
10	bill will not originate in the house for that legislature.
11	(5) designate each concurrent resolution received as a
12	"Texas Concurrent Resolution" (or T.C.R.) and number the concurrent
13	resolution using only odd numbers if the general appropriations
14	bill will originate in the house for that legislature; and
15	(6) designate each concurrent resolution received as a
16	"Texas Concurrent Resolution" (or T.C.R.) and number the concurrent
17	resolution using only even numbers if the general appropriations
18	bill will not originate in the house for that legislature.
