1 WHEREAS, The members of People's Missionary Baptist Church in

3 S. M. Wright II for 24 years of dedicated service to their

6 Missionary Baptist Church from his father, the late Reverend
7 Sylvester Wright Sr., who led the house of worship from 1957 until

17 and it also sponsors a host of noteworthy events, including the
18 Thanksgiving Day Giveaway and Christmas in the Park; and

20 endeavors, Pastor S. M. Wright II has made a lasting and positive
21 difference in many lives, and the occasion of his 24th pastoral
22 anniversary provides a welcome opportunity to recognize his
