R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Texas Rural Water Association is holding its
2 50th annual convention in Austin from March 27 through March 29,
3 2019, and attendees are gathering at the State Capitol on March 27
4 to celebrate Rural Water Day; and

5 WHEREAS, Established in 1969, the Texas Rural Water
6 Association is a statewide trade organization with an active
7 membership of more than 750 nonprofit water supply corporations,
8 small-town water departments, special utility districts, municipal
9 utility districts, investor-owned utilities, and water control and
10 improvement districts that serve approximately 2.5 million people;

12 WHEREAS, TRWA is dedicated to helping directors, managers,
13 and operators provide efficient service and clean, safe drinking
14 water; it also encourages education and information exchange,
15 offers member support services, and handles legislative and
16 regulatory representation; moreover, the association advocates
17 reasonable, practical, and affordable rules regarding rural and
18 small water and wastewater systems; and

19 WHEREAS, For half a century, TRWA has done its best to "Keep
20 Texas Rural" by ensuring access to safe and affordable water and
21 wastewater systems for those who produce food and fiber and for
22 communities in every part of the Lone Star State, and Rural Water
23 Day provides a fitting opportunity to commend the association and
24 its member organizations for their valuable public service; now,

3 Legislature hereby recognize March 27, 2019, as Rural Water Day at
