RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, May 2019 has been set aside as Asian American and 2 Pacific Islander Heritage Month to recognize the accomplishments 3 and wide-ranging contributions of individuals who trace their 4 ancestry to Asia and the Pacific Islands; and

5 WHEREAS, Originally established by the United States 6 Congress as Asian-Pacific American Heritage Week, the observance 7 celebrates the diverse culture, traditions, and history of people 8 from the Asian continent and the islands of Melanesia, Micronesia, 9 and Polynesia in the Pacific; it was officially expanded into a 10 monthlong celebration in 1992; and

11 WHEREAS, The month of May was chosen for this commemorative 12 period because of two key events in our nation's history; on May 7, 13 1843, the first Japanese immigrants arrived, and on May 10, 1869, a 14 workforce largely composed of Chinese laborers completed the 15 Transcontinental Railroad; and

WHEREAS, In 2013, the Pew Research Center released a report 16 highlighting the tremendous progress that has been made by Asian 17 18 Americans; the study noted that a century ago, most were low-skilled, low-wage laborers subject to official discrimination; 19 today, however, Asian Americans rank as the racial group with the 20 21 highest levels of income and education in the nation; since approximately 2000, Asian Americans have also constituted the 22 23 fastest-growing racial group in the United States, largely because 24 of immigration; in addition, Asians who have recently arrived in

1 this country are about three times more likely than other 2 immigrants to be sponsored for permanent residency by an employer; 3 the Pew report further noted that over 60 percent of new Asian 4 immigrants age 25 to 64 held at least a bachelor's degree; and

5 WHEREAS, The Lone Star State is home to generations of 6 Americans who take great pride in their family roots in Asia and the 7 Pacific Islands, and this annual observance provides a welcome 8 opportunity to celebrate their significant contributions to the 9 prosperity and cultural vibrancy of our nation; now, therefore, be 10 it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas 12 Legislature hereby recognize May 2019 as Asian American and Pacific 13 Islander Heritage Month.
