R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Public-spirited citizens from across the Lone Star
2 State are gathering in Austin on April 2, 2019, to advocate for
3 women and their families during Blue Ribbon Lobby Day at the State
4 Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, Organizers Carol Jablonski and Tammie Hartgroves of
6 Texas Democratic Women and Crystal Perkins, executive director of
7 the Texas Democratic Party, are joined by concerned women and
8 leaders from around the state on Blue Ribbon Lobby Day, which
9 provides an occasion to bring attention to issues important to
10 Texas women, including public education, health care, and economic
11 security; and
