R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Texas Gun Sense volunteers from across the state are
2 gathering in Austin on April 2, 2019, to observe Texas Gun Sense
3 Advocacy Day at the State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, Established in 2007 in the wake of the Virginia Tech
5 shooting, Texas Gun Sense is a nonprofit that supports
6 common-sense, evidence-based solutions for reducing gun-related
7 injuries and deaths; advocates work with fellow Texans and
8 lawmakers to address public health issues related to gun violence;

10 WHEREAS, Texas Gun Sense seeks to educate the public on
11 effective ways to secure guns in order to reduce crime and personal
12 injury, as well as raise awareness about suicide prevention and the
13 safe storage of firearms; the organization further acts as a
14 resource of information about federal, state, and local gun

17 keep the people of the Lone Star State safe from avoidable accidents
18 and injuries through its support of sensible firearm policy, and
19 the organization's legislative day provides a welcome opportunity
