## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, A life made rich through meaningful service drew to 2 a close with the passing of Michael William Lehr, former executive director of the Texas Retired Teachers Association, on January 17, 3 2019, at the age of 89; and 4 WHEREAS, Born on December 22, 1929, to Louisa and George Lehr 5 at his family's farm in Wall, Mike Lehr was the youngest of five 6 7 children; he experienced the tragic loss of both his mother and father at an early age and was raised by his maternal aunt and her 8 9 husband, Betty and John Mees; the family moved to Abilene during his early childhood, and he distinguished himself in high school as a 10 11 football player and a member of the track team; following his 12 graduation from Abilene High School in 1948, he enrolled at McMurry College, where he earned his bachelor's degree and, later, a 13 14 master's degree; and WHEREAS, Mr. Lehr became a teacher and coach in Christoval in 15 16 1952, and from there, he went on to work for the school districts in Eola and San Angelo; after transitioning into administration, he 17 served as principal of Travis Elementary, Bowie Elementary, and 18 John Glenn Jr. High in San Angelo, and in 1971 he accepted a 19 20 position as assistant director of special programs with Austin ISD; 21 he was promoted many times during his tenure with that district, and he retired as its executive director of personnel in 1985; his 22 23 experience also encompassed service as a legislative aide to State Representative Tom C. Massey in the 1970s and as a founder and 24

- 1 president of the Association for Compensatory Educators of Texas;

- 4 performed contract work for the Texas Association of School Boards,
- 5 and in 1987 he became the legislative coordinator for the Texas
- 6 Retired Teachers Association; in that role, he successfully
- 7 supported legislation that funded a much-needed pay increase for
- 8 retired educators, an achievement that won him an outpouring of
- 9 gratitude; he was named the organization's executive director in
- 10 1994, and he continued to work in behalf of the association's
- 11 members until his retirement in 2003; and
- WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Lehr enjoyed the love and
- 13 support of his wife of 44 years, Francine Lehr; he was the proud
- 14 father of three children, Richard, Alan, and Susan, and with the
- 15 passing years, he saw his family grow to include his grandchildren,
- 16 Ellen, Grant, William, and Abigail, and a great-granddaughter,
- 17 Finley; and
- 18 WHEREAS, A respected educator and an effective advocate for
- 19 the teaching profession, Mike Lehr made a positive difference in
- 20 the lives of numerous Texans, and he leaves behind a legacy that
- 21 will continue to resonate for years to come; now, therefore, be it

- 23 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Michael William
- 24 Lehr and extend sincere sympathy to his family and many friends;
