1 WHEREAS, Dr. David Del Bosque is retiring as superintendent 2 of the Avalon Independent School District on August 31, 2019, 3 drawing to a close an exemplary tenure in education that has spanned 4 39 years; and

5 WHEREAS, Dr. Del Bosque began his career in 1980, when he joined the staff at Navarro College; he served the school as a 6 7 counselor and academic advisor before receiving a promotion to coordinator of special services; in 1982, he accepted a job as a 8 9 counselor and faculty associate at The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston, and three years later he became the principal 10 of St. John High School in Ennis, a position he held for nearly a 11 12 decade; and

13 WHEREAS, In 1994, Dr. Del Bosque joined Avalon ISD, and over 14 the course of his 25 years with the district, he has contributed in a wide variety of roles, including as a Spanish and ESL teacher, 15 16 baseball coach, and junior high and high school principal; in addition, he has served as the district's director of special 17 programs and as associate superintendent; since assuming the title 18 of superintendent in 2002, he has overseen the development of the 19 20 Avalon ISD special education program and the district's transition 21 into the South Ellis County Shared Services Cooperative; and

22 WHEREAS, Through his unwavering commitment to Avalon ISD, 23 David Del Bosque has led the way in fostering a supportive and 24 challenging educational environment for area students, and he may
