1 WHEREAS, Battalion Chief Juan Perez has been named
2 Firefighter of the Year for 2018 by the Corpus Christi Fire
3 Department in recognition of his outstanding service; and

4 WHEREAS, A member of the department since 2002, "Tony" Perez
5 is assigned to Fire Station No. 5, where he has earned the respect
6 and admiration of his colleagues by taking on such additional
7 responsibilities as hazardous materials and rescue training as well
8 as career development; he is the first battalion chief to be named
9 Firefighter of the Year; and

10 WHEREAS, Chief Perez also received the Medal of Valor award,
11 the department's second-highest honor, for the critical role he
12 played in rescuing an elderly woman from a burning house; in
13 February 2018, Chief Perez and another firefighter were among the
14 first on the scene, and, without wearing protective gear, they
15 braved the smoke-filled home and quickly found the woman and
16 brought her out to safety; and

17 WHEREAS, Tony Perez has demonstrated uncommon dedication,
18 leadership, and courage as he has worked to protect the lives and
19 property of his fellow citizens, and he is truly deserving of
20 special recognition; now, therefore, be it

22 Legislature hereby congratulate Battalion Chief Juan "Tony" Perez
23 on being named 2018 Firefighter of the Year by the Corpus Christi
