R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Peyton Phillips of Austin won the first annual K1
2 Speed E-World Championship in Irvine, California, on March 23,
3 2019; and

4 WHEREAS, Peyton's journey to becoming the inaugural K1 Speed
5 Indoor Go Kart Racing world champion began at the organization's
6 Texas competition on February 24, where he claimed the state title
7 and an invitation to represent the Lone Star State in the national
8 competition in California; and

9 WHEREAS, Competing against 11 drivers from across the
10 country, Peyton made a comeback from a slow start in the Wildcard
11 consolation bracket to reach the tournament's final four; he edged
12 into the lead in a series of head-to-head matchups, besting his
13 opponents by a margin of just 0.124 seconds to be crowned the United
14 States champion; and

15 WHEREAS, Peyton advanced to the international finals the
16 following morning, going up against drivers from Puerto Rico,
17 Canada, Mexico, and China to race for the ultimate prize; in the
18 course of the day, participants competed for the best times on three
19 different tracks in Ontario, Anaheim, and Irvine, with Peyton
20 coming out on top to capture the first-ever indoor electric karting
21 world championship; and

22 WHEREAS, Demonstrating hard work, skill, and unwavering
23 determination in the pursuit of his goals, Peyton Phillips has
24 proven himself to be a source of great pride to his family and his

1 community, and his impressive accomplishments are indeed deserving
2 of recognition; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
4 Legislature hereby congratulate Peyton Phillips on winning the 2019
5 K1 Speed E-World Championship and extend to him sincere best wishes
6 for continued success; and, be it further

7 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
8 prepared for Peyton as an expression of high regard by the Texas
9 House of Representatives.
