

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Area Texans are joining together on May 18, 2019, to
2 celebrate the grand reopening of the Grand Prairie Animal Services
3 and Adoption Center; and

4 WHEREAS, First opened in 2003, the Grand Prairie Animal
5 Services and Adoption Center has been undergoing an expansion and
6 renovation project since March 2017 to accommodate the influx of
7 homeless animals in the city; with the remodeling of the facility,
8 the shelter has effectively tripled its cat capacity, doubled its
9 dog capacity, and added outdoor play spaces as well as a
10 "Get-to-Know-You" courtyard for dogs; and

11 WHEREAS, Made possible by the diligent and cooperative
12 efforts of many community leaders, the remodeled shelter is
13 equipped with a new air-conditioning system that provides improved
14 air filtering and a healthier environment for the animals;
15 furthermore, the facility now includes an upgraded spay and neuter
16 clinic, which will increase the number of surgeries performed each
17 week; and

18 WHEREAS, The newly refurbished Grand Prairie Animal Services
19 and Adoption Center will serve as an invaluable resource for the
20 community for years to come, and all those who contributed to its
21 renovation and expansion may indeed take justifiable pride in
22 bringing this project to fruition; now, therefore, be it
