- 9 WHEREAS, Mayor Taylor began his two-decade-long career in
- 10 public safety as a bailiff with Hays County; in 2000, he joined the
- 11 county sheriff's office as a corrections officer, and he became a
- 12 sheriff's deputy the following year; during his tenure with the
- 13 agency, his responsibilities included supervising and managing
- 14 crime prevention, community outreach, and public information
- 15 teams; he also oversaw the School Resource Officer program for
- 16 three districts in Hays County before the Hays Consolidated
- 17 Independent School District hired him as its first director of
- 18 safety and security in 2018; and
- 19 WHEREAS, A longtime member of the city council in Mountain
- 20 City, this dedicated civic leader was named mayor in 2016, and he
- 21 won reelection to that office two years later; he further
- 22 contributed to his community as a member of the Kyle Volunteer Fire
- 23 Department and as a volunteer emergency management specialist with
- 24 the Hays County Office of Emergency Management; and
