R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Jacob Henry Neidig of Elgin High School has

4 WHEREAS, The son of Harlan and Juanita Neidig, Mr. Neidig has
5 demonstrated great intellect and aptitude and a dedication to the

7 Scholar and a National Hispanic Scholar, he is currently ranked
8 first in his class at Elgin High School with a 4.0 grade point

12 baseball teams and participating in cross-country, powerlifting,
13 tennis, and golf; he is a member of the Fellowship of Christian

8 degree, working as a civil rights attorney, and pursuing a career in
