1 WHEREAS, Residents of Calhoun County lost an admired public 2 servant and a friend to many with the passing of former Port Lavaca mayor Ida Mae Browning on April 8, 2019, at the age of 91; and 3 WHEREAS, The daughter of Lee and Mary Birmingham, the former 4 5 "Tiney" Birmingham was born in Port Lavaca on June 28, 1927, and grew up with four siblings, Roemer, Leslie, Dempsey, and Lorraine; 6 7 early in her career, she worked at Bauer Dredging as an executive secretary and supervisor of accounting before leaving to care for 8 9 her ailing mother; she was later employed as an executive secretary at First State Bank and Gary Aircraft; in 1964, she married 10 11 B. B. Browning, and they became the parents of a daughter, Tanya, 12 and a son, Bryan; through the years, she welcomed into her treasured family nine grandchildren, and she helped raise two of them; she was 13 14 further blessed with four great-grandchildren; and WHEREAS, Mrs. Browning became the first woman elected to the 15 16 Port Lavaca City Council, and after serving for 10 years, she became the city's first female mayor; over the course of an administration 17 that spanned a decade, she worked tirelessly for infrastructure 18 including the mitigation of 19 improvements, erosion, the 20 construction of the fishing pier, and the development of the iconic 21 Lighthouse Beach; and WHEREAS, After leaving office in 2000, Mrs. Browning 22 23 continued to benefit her fellow citizens as a member of the city
