

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Allen High School boys' wrestling team furthered
2 its tradition of success by winning the 6A team title at the 2019
3 University Interscholastic League Wrestling State Tournament, held
4 February 22 and 23 in Cypress; and

5 WHEREAS, Besting their closest competitor by more than 103
6 points, the Eagles captured their 10th consecutive state team
7 championship; the Allen wrestlers collected five individual gold
8 medals, with state titles being claimed by Braxton Brown at 113
9 pounds, Trent Dooley at 138 pounds, Mario Danzi at 145 pounds, Elise
10 Brown Ton at 152 pounds, and Johnny Green at 285 pounds; and

11 WHEREAS, Also contributing to Allen's impressive showing
12 were Kade Moore, who was second at 106 pounds, Gabe Martinez, who
13 took third at 120 pounds, Noah Yeamans, who finished fifth at 126
14 pounds, Alejandro Cavazos, who claimed sixth at 160 pounds, Will
15 Villegas, who secured fifth at 170 pounds, Nate Dooley, who was
16 third at 182 pounds, and Zane Davis, who finished fourth at 195
17 pounds; and

18 WHEREAS, Benefiting from the able guidance of head coach
19 Jerry Best and assistant coach Todd Wyckoff, the Eagles qualified a
20 contingent of 13 wrestlers for the state meet and were represented
21 in every weight class but one; the team enjoyed additional support
22 throughout the 2019 campaign from athletic director Steve Williams
23 and assistant athletic director Kim Garner; and

24 WHEREAS, The undisputed kings of high school wrestling in the

1 Lone Star State, the Allen High School Eagles have realized a
2 remarkable accomplishment by winning their 10th consecutive state
3 team championship, and they are a source of great pride for their
4 fellow students and their many supporters in the community; now,
5 therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
7 Legislature hereby congratulate the Allen High School boys'
8 wrestling team on winning the 6A title at the 2019 UIL state
9 tournament and extend to all those associated with the team sincere
