1 WHEREAS, Connor Sears of Gold-Burg High School distinguished
2 himself with his outstanding performance at The Vegas Shoot 2019,
3 held February 8 through 10 at the South Point Hotel and Casino in
4 Las Vegas; and

5 WHEREAS, Known as the world's largest and most prestigious
6 indoor archery tournament, The Vegas Shoot attracts archers from
7 all 50 states and 50 countries around the globe; the 2019 event
8 boasted a record number of 3,767 participants, along with more than
9 6,000 spectators; and

10 WHEREAS, During three days of qualifying competition,
11 Mr. Sears shot a perfect score of 900, becoming only the third
12 person in the young adult amateur division to achieve such a feat in
13 the event's 53-year history; the compound archery championship
14 contest came down to a hard-fought shootout in which Mr. Sears
15 turned in a valiant effort but ultimately fell to his opponent,
16 finishing second overall; and

17 WHEREAS, The son of David and Pam Sears, Mr. Sears is
18 currently a senior at Gold-Burg High; following his graduation, he
19 plans to attend Texas A&M University, where he will shoot for the
20 school's archery team; and

21 WHEREAS, Demonstrating superlative skill and accuracy at The
22 Vegas Shoot 2019, Connor Sears has brought great pride to his
23 family, his community, and the Lone Star State, and it is indeed
24 fitting to recognize his notable achievements; now, therefore, be
