12 WHEREAS, When she was 14 years old, she married Chris Alec Uselton in a ceremony conducted at Red River Station; they resided 13 14 in Nocona before settling in Belcherville on a portion of the Crenshaw Ranch; after losing a child in infancy, they went on to 15 raise three other children, Tommy Lee, Bobby Joe "Joe Boy," and 16 Linda Bay; her strong work ethic served her well on the busy ranch, 17 and she took on numerous responsibilities, from cooking for hired 18 hands to breaking ice for the cows in winter; she and her first 19 husband shared a rewarding relationship of nearly a half-century 20 until his passing in 1982; subsequently, she was joined in 21 matrimony to Ross Roberson, who died in 1997; and 22

23 WHEREAS, Mrs. Roberson became the beloved "Nina" of five 24 treasured grandchildren, and she provided them with many happy

1 times on the ranch while teaching them a wide range of skills and life lessons; through the years, she has also been blessed with 10 2 3 great-grandchildren and 8 great-great-grandchildren; although she gave up driving her pickup truck at the age of 98, she continues to 4 5 enjoy fishing, antiquing, doing yard work, riding with grandchildren or her son to "check the cows", walking, visiting 6 friends, going to the lake cabin with family, and sharing funny 7 8 stories; she was a longtime volunteer with the Nocona General Hospital Auxiliary and Meals on Wheels, and she is a member of the 9 10 First Baptist Church; and
