

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Terry G. McCoy of Austin is retiring from the Texas  
2 Department of Transportation on May 31, 2019, drawing to a close an  
3 outstanding career with the agency that has spanned more than three  
4 decades; and

5           WHEREAS, The son of a TxDOT career employee, Terry McCoy  
6 first joined the department while he was still in school, working  
7 during the summers in the Burnet Resident Engineer's Office; after  
8 graduating from Texas A&M University in 1988, he accepted a  
9 position with the department as an engineering assistant in the  
10 newly formed Austin District South Travis area office; four years  
11 later, he was selected to participate in the TxDOT Master's  
12 Program, and he earned a master's degree in civil engineering from  
13 The University of Texas in 1993; and

14           WHEREAS, Mr. McCoy subsequently worked in the geometric  
15 design section of the agency's design division and then served as  
16 design engineer for the New Braunfels area office in the San Antonio  
17 District; in 2002, he returned to the Austin District as Burnet area  
18 engineer, and he later held the roles of North Travis area engineer  
19 and director of transportation, planning, and development before  
20 retiring as deputy district engineer in 2015; he rejoined the  
21 department in January 2016, and since that time, he has served as  
22 Austin District engineer; his honors include the 2013 Luther  
23 DeBerry Award as well as the 2018 Man of the Year Award from the  
24 Heart of Texas WTS Chapter; and

1           WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. McCoy enjoys the love and  
2 support of his wife, Becky, and their two daughters, Hannah and  
3 Claire; and

4           WHEREAS, Terry McCoy's dedication, professionalism, and  
5 commitment to excellence have greatly benefited his fellow Texans  
6 and earned him the respect and admiration of his peers, and he may  
7 indeed reflect with pride on a career well spent as he embarks on  
8 the next exciting chapter of his life; now, therefore, be it

9           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas  
10 Legislature hereby congratulate Terry G. McCoy on his retirement  
11 from the Texas Department of Transportation and extend to him  
12 sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further

13           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
14 prepared for Mr. McCoy as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
15 House of Representatives.
