1           WHEREAS, The citizens of Kimble County lost an esteemed  
2 community leader with the passing of Donnie J. Coleman on April 4,  
3 2019, at the age of 75; and

4           WHEREAS, Born to Ralph and Jeanne Nelson on December 13,  
5 1943, the former Donnie Nelson grew up in Pensacola, Florida, with  
6 her sister, Carolyn; she attended Florida State University, and  
7 following her graduation in 1966, she moved to the Houston area,  
8 where she met her future husband, Gene Coleman; the couple married  
9 in 1967 and shared a rewarding marriage that spanned nearly five  
10 decades until Mr. Coleman passed away in 2016; and

11           WHEREAS, Ms. Coleman taught school for many years before  
12 returning to college and earning her law degree from St. Mary's  
13 University; admitted to the State Bar of Texas in 1979, she  
14 prosecuted numerous cases as a trial lawyer and eventually assumed  
15 the post of Kimble County attorney; dedicated to protecting  
16 children from abuse, she helped to bring sex-offender registration  
17 to the area and to establish the Kids' Advocacy Place in Kerrville;  
18 she further contributed to her community through her involvement  
19 with the chamber of commerce, the Friends of the South Llano River  
20 State Park, and the Kimble County Wild Game Dinner; and

21           WHEREAS, Over the years, Ms. Coleman was blessed with a fine  
22 family that included her children, Jean, Shelly, Robert, and Glen,  
23 as well as her eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren;  
24 in her spare time, she loved traveling with her husband, and she

1 counted reading and listening to bluegrass, Cajun, and country  
2 music among her favorite activities; and

3 WHEREAS, Donnie Coleman led a life that was rich in personal  
4 and professional achievements, and she will forever be a source of  
5 inspiration to those she leaves behind; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas  
7 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Donnie J. Coleman  
8 and extend heartfelt sympathy to all who mourn her passing; and, be  
9 it further

10 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
11 prepared for her family and that when the Texas House of  
12 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Donnie  
13 Coleman.
