2 Woodville Independent School District on June 30, 2019, after
3 nearly four decades in education; and

4 WHEREAS, Glen Conner began his career in 1981, when he took a
5 position as an agriculture teacher at Woodville High School; he
6 went on to serve in administration in the Hardin, Zavalla, and
7 Chester Independent School Districts before becoming the
8 superintendent of schools for Chester ISD in 1998; and

9 WHEREAS, This esteemed educator subsequently returned to
10 Woodville ISD as the superintendent of schools in January 2006;
11 during an exceptional tenure that has spanned more than 12 years, he
12 has ably led the district in fostering a supportive and challenging
13 educational environment for area students; and

14 WHEREAS, Active in his professional community, Mr. Conner is
15 a member of the Delta Tau Alpha Agricultural Honor Society and the
16 Texas Association of School Administrators; moreover, he has given
17 back to his fellow citizens through his involvement with the
18 Woodville Lions Club and the Tyler County Dogwood Festival, and he
19 is a deacon at First Baptist Church Woodville; and

20 WHEREAS, A 1978 graduate of Warren High School, Mr. Conner
21 holds a bachelor's degree in agriculture from Sam Houston State
22 University and a master's degree in secondary education from
23 Stephen F. Austin State University; in all his endeavors, he has
24 enjoyed the love and support of his wife of nearly 40 years, Joan,
