17	and General Staff College; today, he serves as board chair of the
18	Unified Veterans of America and the National Guard Association of
19	Texas and as a board member of the Aviation Science and Technology
20	Department of Texas Southern University and the Adjutant General
21	Board of Retired Executives; and
22	WHEREAS, General Bailey is held in high regard by his fellow
23	citizens for his professionalism and commitment to the ideals of
24	the United States armed forces, and he may reflect with pride on his
