6 designations on only 10 women around the world who have made
7 innovative strides in the field of unmanned aircraft systems;

11 Academy and holds a degree from the University of Pennsylvania; in
12 2016, she and Nick Madincea established Drone Parks Worldwide, an
13 indoor drone center and entertainment company that focuses on
14 increasing the accessibility of drone technology; the enterprise
15 works in close partnership with the Lone Star Flight Museum to
16 create an educational, experimental, and hands-on environment in
17 which members of the general public can learn to fly
18 first-person-view drone aircraft; in addition, Ms. Ferrone and
19 Mr. Madincea have led an Industry-Academia workshop at the
20 Massachusetts Institute of Technology on micro drone racing and
21 course design and have presented a TEDx Talk at Texas A&M
22 University; and

23 WHEREAS, Through the skill and determination she brings to
24 all her efforts, Marjorie Ferrone has earned the esteem of her peers

1 and made contributions to the UAS industry that will resonate far
2 into the future; now, therefore, be it
