

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Georgetown High School boys' swim team achieved
2 great distinction by winning the 5A team championship at the 2019
3 University Interscholastic League Swimming and Diving State Meet;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, In a season-long display of talent and
6 determination, the Eagles won the district and regional titles to
7 earn a return trip to the state meet, where they had finished second
8 among the 5A contenders in 2018; and

9 WHEREAS, Competing on February 15 and 16, 2019, at the Lee and
10 Joe Jamail Texas Swimming Center in Austin, Georgetown clinched the
11 first state crown in program history; the Eagles were paced in the
12 individual events by Greyson Alarcon, who set a 5A state record time
13 of 48.05 seconds in the 100-yard butterfly and also won the 100-yard
14 backstroke; Corby Furrer collected gold and silver medals,
15 respectively, in the 500-yard and 200-yard freestyle races, and
16 William Corona was second in both the 200-yard individual medley
17 and the 100-yard freestyle; and

18 WHEREAS, In relay competition, Mr. Furrer, Mr. Corona, and
19 Greyson Alarcon were part of two gold medal-winning squads; they
20 joined with Daniel Pineiro in notching a 5A state record time of 3
21 minutes, 5.16 seconds, in the 400-yard freestyle relay, and they
22 teamed with Landon Alarcon to clock in at 1 minute, 24.87 seconds,
23 in the 200-yard freestyle relay; and

24 WHEREAS, Landon Alarcon also competed in the 200-yard

1 individual medley and the 100-yard breaststroke, placing 6th and
2 7th, respectively, and Mr. Pineiro recorded 8th- and 13th-place
3 finishes in the 200-yard and 100-yard freestyle races; and

4 WHEREAS, These talented young Texans have distinguished
5 themselves through their skill, hard work, and enduring commitment
6 to excellence, and they may indeed reflect with pride on their
7 extraordinary accomplishments; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
9 Legislature hereby congratulate the Georgetown High School boys'
10 swim team on winning the 5A state championship at the 2019 UIL
11 Swimming and Diving State Meet and extend to all those associated
12 with the team sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it
13 further

14 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
15 prepared for the Georgetown Eagles as an expression of high regard
16 by the Texas House of Representatives.
