1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will long cherish their memories
2 of Jackie Gene Miller Sr. of Italy, Texas, who passed away on April
3 15, 2019, at the age of 85; and

4 WHEREAS, The son of Earl and Lysca Miller, Jackie Miller was
5 born in Akron, Ohio, on July 10, 1933, and he grew up with a sister,
6 Marjorie; a multisport athlete at Italy High School, he graduated
7 in 1951 and worked at Vought Aeronautics before serving five years
8 as a U.S. Air Force sergeant in the Korean War; he then returned to
9 Vought Aeronautics as a production manager; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller married the former Pat Crow in 1958, and
11 the couple lived in Greenville, where he was employed by Farmers
12 Insurance; moving back to Ellis County in 1963, he again worked for
13 Vought Aeronautics and attended evening classes at The University
14 of Texas at Arlington; in the early 1970s, he purchased the Italy
15 Auto Supply store, which he owned and managed until 1995; and

16 WHEREAS, Following his retirement from private business,
17 Mr. Miller served as the Ellis County commissioner for Precinct 3;
18 he was actively involved with Italy Masonic Lodge No. 647, and he
19 further benefited his community as a school board member and
20 booster club president; and

21 WHEREAS, Above all else, Mr. Miller treasured time spent with
22 his family; he shared six rewarding decades of marriage with his
23 wife, and he was a devoted father to their son, Jackie Miller Jr.;
24 moreover, he took great pride in his beloved granddaughter, Lexie;

1 an avid sports fan, horse racing enthusiast, and history buff,
2 Mr. Miller also enjoyed reading, working in the yard, and
3 barbecuing; and

4 WHEREAS, Jackie Miller led a life of caring devotion to his
5 loved ones, and although he is deeply missed, he will forever hold a
6 special place in the hearts of those he leaves behind; now,
7 therefore, be it
