1 WHEREAS, Dr. Nghia Le, a teacher at Booker T. Washington High 2 School and The High School for Engineering Professions in Houston, 3 was recognized in the Leadership Secondary category at the 18th 4 annual H-E-B Excellence in Education Awards on May 5, 2019; and

5 WHEREAS, H-E-B established the Excellence in Education 6 Awards program in 2002 to celebrate outstanding public school 7 professionals in the Lone Star State; the Leadership Award honors 8 teachers with 10 to 20 years of experience in the classroom, and 9 each winner receives a \$10,000 cash prize as well as a \$10,000 grant 10 for his or her school; and

11 WHEREAS, A longtime member of the Washington High School 12 faculty, Dr. Le started the school's rocketry program 14 years ago, and his students have participated in a wide range of unique 13 14 learning experiences under his leadership, such as collaborating with NASA scientists, constructing a Mars rover, building a 15 16 prosthetic arm using 3-D printing, and working with Rydings College in Zimbabwe on wind turbine and portable water filtration projects; 17 he currently teaches courses in alternative energy, high power 18 rocketry, and science and technology to students in 9th through 19 20 12th grade; and
