

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, PJ Putnam, a U.S. Air Force veteran and Dallas-based
2 corporate attorney, bravely risked his own safety to render
3 assistance to the victim of a major truck accident on Interstate 35
4 on April 24, 2019; and

5 WHEREAS, At approximately 11 a.m., Mr. Putnam was traveling
6 through Salado during a heavy rainstorm, when a sudden wind shear
7 caused two 18-wheelers on the highway to collide; one of the trucks
8 jackknifed into a guard rail while the other careened through three
9 lanes of traffic, before rolling over and sliding to a stop at the
10 edge of the freeway; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Putnam, who narrowly managed to avoid being in
12 the path of the crashing semis, exited his vehicle and quickly
13 ensured that the driver of the jackknifed truck was not seriously
14 injured; he then approached the overturned vehicle, where he found
15 the second motorist in shock and unable to free himself from the
16 cab; with the help of a bystander, Mr. Putnam carried the driver a
17 safe distance away from the vehicle; he then used his first aid
18 training to treat the man for shock until emergency medical crews
19 could take over; thanks in large part to Mr. Putnam's swift
20 response, there were no fatalities or serious injuries; and

21 WHEREAS, In the immediate aftermath of a harrowing accident,
22 PJ Putnam heroically sprang into action to rescue a fellow citizen,
23 and his efforts on that day have distinguished him as an individual
24 of outstanding courage and character; now, therefore, be it
