Today's 2019 list of the 10 Best Zoos in North America; and

3 WHEREAS, The publication has conducted its Best Zoo poll for 4 the past three years, and the Fort Worth Zoo has placed in the top 5 five each time; the top 20 were chosen by a panel of travel and 6 lifestyle industry experts, and the top 10 were selected by public 7 poll; and

WHEREAS, Established in 1909, the Fort Worth Zoo is one of the 8 9 oldest continuously operating zoos in the Lone Star State; it is home to more than 540 species of animals from around the globe, 10 11 including representatives of all four species of great apes and the 12 most successful breeding colony of lesser flamingos in the world; the zoo also houses one of the largest collections of reptiles in 13 14 the United States, and it is an international leader in Asian 15 elephant conservation; and

16 WHEREAS, More than 100 species at the zoo are part of the 17 Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) Species Survival Plan, 18 including 68 endangered or threatened species; the zoo's new 19 African Savannah exhibit features giraffes, zebras, hippos, and 20 rhinoceroses, and in 2011, the zoo received top honors from the AZA 21 for excellence in the areas of live animal display and exhibit 22 design; and

23 WHEREAS, For more than a century, the Fort Worth Zoo has been 24 delighting and informing visitors about the wonders of the animal
