## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Mart High School football team once again proved
itself one of the finest in Texas by winning the 2018 University
Interscholastic League 2A Division 2 state championship; and

WHEREAS, The defending champs in their class, the Panthers won 9 of 10 regular-season contests and claimed the District 11 title; Mart continued to excel throughout the playoffs, defeating Saratoga West Hardin, Simms Bowie, Grapeland, Muenster, and Falls City High Schools to earn its 11th trip to the state championship contest; and

WHEREAS, Competing in front of a crowd of more than 7,000 fans 10 11 at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Mart faced off against Gruver High 12 School in the December 19 finale; the Panthers unleashed a devastating ground assault, rushing for nine touchdowns in the 13 14 first half alone; by intermission, the team had already set the record for the most points scored in a 2A state championship game, 15 16 and it ultimately rang up a total of 76 to achieve a commanding victory; when the final seconds ticked off the clock, Mart 17 collected its seventh title overall and celebrated the first 18 back-to-back crowns in program history; and 19

20 WHEREAS, The Panthers were led by Offensive Most Valuable 21 Player Tyrek Horne, who ran for seven touchdowns and 291 yards to 22 set a pair of 2A title game records; on the other side of the ball, 23 Defensive MVP Jacob Ybarra paced Mart with 6.5 tackles, two 24 interceptions, and four pass breakups; ably guided by head coach
