R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Texans and people around the globe were deeply  
2 saddened by the campus shooting that took place at Santa Fe High  
3 School on May 18, 2018, which resulted in the loss of 10 innocent  
4 lives; and

5           WHEREAS, The victims included eight students, Jared Conard  
6 Black, Shana Fisher, Christian Riley Garcia, Aaron Kyle McLeod,  
7 Angelique Ramirez, Sabika Sheikh, Christopher Stone, and Kimberly  
8 Vaughan, who ranged in age from 14 to 18; also killed were two  
9 substitute teachers, Glenda Ann Perkins and Cynthia Tisdale, and 13  
10 other individuals were wounded in the attack; and

11           WHEREAS, First responders and school resource officers  
12 demonstrated outstanding bravery in helping evacuate the building  
13 and in confronting, containing, and ultimately apprehending the  
14 gunman; and

15           WHEREAS, The incident has deeply impacted the town of Santa  
16 Fe; present on that fateful day were 1,435 students and 85 teachers,  
17 and they, along with the bereaved families of the victims, have  
18 experienced immense heartbreak; though the journey to healing has  
19 proven difficult, the community has shown its resilience and  
20 compassion during this time of need, as neighbors have come  
21 together to support and comfort those most affected; and

22           WHEREAS, In pausing to reflect on this solemn anniversary, we  
23 remember those whose lives were lost, and our hearts go out to the  
24 many whose lives were forever altered; now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas  
2 Legislature hereby extend condolences to the people of Santa Fe on  
3 the occasion of the one-year anniversary of the Santa Fe High School  
4 shooting and commend the efforts of those who have promoted unity  
5 and healing in the aftermath of this tragedy.
