

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The members of First United Methodist Church
2 Waxahachie are celebrating the 170th anniversary of their church's
3 founding on June 9, 2019; and

4 WHEREAS, This venerable religious institution can trace its
5 origins back to 1849, when the Reverend Falacius Reynolds organized
6 a formal Methodist society in Waxahachie; three years later, the
7 congregation built its first sanctuary on what is now East Franklin
8 Street, and a second building was soon constructed on the adjoining
9 lot; after nearly four decades, the church found a new home on
10 College Street, where it remained for more than half a century, and
11 in 1950, it moved to its current location on West Marvin Avenue; in
12 2000, the church added a 24,000-square-foot family life center to
13 its campus; and

14 WHEREAS, Over the years, First United Methodist Church
15 Waxahachie has benefited from the dedicated efforts of many
16 outstanding pastors, including the Reverend Dr. Kevin Tully, who
17 leads the congregation today; and

18 WHEREAS, First United Methodist Church Waxahachie has long
19 served as a source of inspiration and guidance to those who worship
20 there, and its continued existence is a testament to the unwavering
21 commitment of its members and clergy, both past and present; now,
22 therefore, be it
