5 Whiskey Co. has built an admirable reputation in the Austin area and  
6 made an important contribution to the city's vibrant craft  
7 distillery scene; and

8           WHEREAS, Still Austin benefits from the inspired leadership  
9 of two married couples, Lisa and Andrew Braunberg and Joanna and Sal  
10 Salinas, and the father-and-son team of Cleveland and Chris Seals;  
11 the first grain-to-glass whiskey distillery within Austin's city  
12 limits since Prohibition, Still Austin uses locally sourced grains  
13 and limestone-filtered water to produce its spirits, and it  
14 performs all of its own milling, mashing, fermenting, distilling,  
15 barreling, and bottling in-house; and

16           WHEREAS, The owners and staff of Still Austin Whiskey Co. are  
17 helping to make the enterprise a Lone Star success story, and they  
18 may take justifiable pride in their achievements; now, therefore,  
19 be it

20           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas  
21 Legislature hereby honor Still Austin Whiskey Co. as a noteworthy  
22 member of the Austin business community and extend to all those  
23 associated with the distillery sincere best wishes for the future;
