RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The DeSoto High School girls' track and field team 2 once again proved itself one of the finest in Texas by winning the 3 6A championship at the 2019 University Interscholastic League Track 4 & Field State Meet; and

5 WHEREAS, Joining the other top high school competitors at Mike A. Myers Stadium in Austin on May 11, the Lady Eagles clinched 6 7 their eighth state crown and fourth consecutive 6A title; setting the pace were the members of the 4x100-meter relay team, Ja'Era 8 9 Griffin, Jayla Hollis, Taylor Armstrong, and Rosaline Effiong, whose victorious time of 44.24 seconds eclipsed the national mark 10 11 they had set at the regional meet two weeks earlier; in addition, 12 Cierra Wash, Ms. Effiong, Zariah Jones, and Bryannia Murphy won the 4x400-meter relay in a national season-best time of 3 minutes, 13 14 39.79 seconds, and Ms. Griffin, Trinity Kirk, Ms. Armstrong, and Mia Abraham triumphed in the 4x200-meter relay; and 15

16 WHEREAS, DeSoto was equally impressive in individual 17 competition, placing six athletes on the podium; Ms. Hollis and 18 Jalaysi'ya Smith claimed gold and silver medals, respectively, in 19 the 100-meter hurdles, and Ms. Armstrong won the 300-meter hurdles; 20 further, Ms. Effiong and Ms. Hollis were second and third in the 21 200-meter dash, and Brianna Washington placed second in discus; and

22 WHEREAS, When the final scores were tallied, the Lady Eagles 23 totaled an astounding 121 points, which set a state meet record and 24 bested their closest competitor by 73 points; in their successful

1 quest to continue their reign as state champions, the DeSoto 2 competitors benefited from the expert guidance of head coach June 3 Villers and the members of her staff; and
