1           WHEREAS, Club Venados has served as a positive influence in  
2 the sport of youth football in Mexico for more than four decades;  
3 and

4           WHEREAS, The organization was founded in Piedras Negras,  
5 Coahuila, in 1976, thanks to the initiative of Mario de la Cabada  
6 Hamelius; today Club Venados is composed of more than 270 players  
7 and cheerleaders representing over 200 member families; mentoring  
8 boys and girls from the ages of 3 to 17, the organization instills  
9 in its members the values of honesty, discipline, respect, and  
10 teamwork; and

11           WHEREAS, In its early years, Club Venados competed against  
12 teams from Mexico City, Monclova, Saltillo, and Torreón as well as  
13 the Texas cities of Dallas and San Antonio; it was incorporated as a  
14 founding partner of the Asociación de Football Americano Infantil  
15 del Norte de Coahuila in 1985; and

16           WHEREAS, Honored 37 times as the association's  
17 top-performing team, Club Venados has claimed 90 championships and  
18 42 second-place finishes since joining the league; moreover, it has  
19 competed in nine bowl games, and it represented AFAINC in the  
20 Governor's Cup in Saltillo in 2018; and

21           WHEREAS, Since 1976, Club Venados has made a meaningful  
22 difference in the lives of countless young people, and its  
23 accomplishments are truly worthy of special recognition; now,  
24 therefore, be it
